

CENTRAL BARK SLEEPOVER GUIDELINES

What does my dog need to bring for their sleepover?

- _____ Adequate food, premeasured in baggies (\$3.00 charge will be applied if CBDDC needs to pre - measure)
- _____ Pre-measured food placed in rodent-proof container (a charge will be applied if CBDDC supplies container)
- _____ A normal-sized blanket or towel is welcome but not necessary (something that can fit in a washer and dryer)
- _____ All medication must be premeasured into pill reminders (original medicine containers must still come with the pet for emergency purposes)
- _____ All items must be labeled with a permanent marker
- _____ A maximum of 2 safe toys in good condition may accompany your dog

What my dog cannot bring...

- Dog beds—Dogs appreciate an old blanket or towels just as much. Certain beds can be preapproved.
- Tennis balls—We have plenty!
- Old broken bones or broken, unsafe toys
- Bowls from home—we have special bowls that attach safely to the dogs crate
